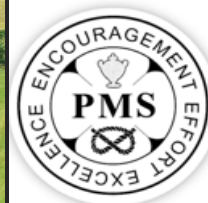

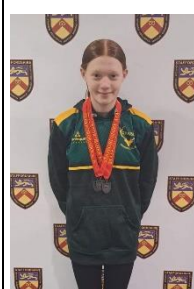
Year 7 have been sent a letter about an information evening for the France 2025 trip, so we look forward to seeing as many Year 7 parents there as possible who are interested in their child attending.
