### **Transition Day 2025 - Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025**

Our team of staff are looking forward to welcoming your child to Penkridge Middle School on **Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025**. The purpose of transition day is to give children a first taste of middle school and to allow them the opportunity to begin to become familiar with their new surroundings.

If your child is currently in Year 4 and attends a local feeder school, please drop them off at their first school on this morning. Marshbrook, Princefield and St. Michaels will communicate with you their own arrangements to transport children to and from Penkridge Middle School on transition day.

If your child is currently in Year 4 and attends St. Leonards or any other out of catchment school, please bring your child to Penkridge Middle School on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025 for 9:30am.

Children should **arrive wearing their current school uniform at 9:30am**. They should also be dressed for the weather (coat, sun cream, hat etc.) and bring a packed lunch, water bottle and pencil case for the day's activities. Children may wish to also bring a small amount of money (no more than £2) to purchase snacks or drinks at break and lunch.

**At 2:30pm children of St. Michaels, Marshbrook and Princefield will walk back to their first school ready to be collected as normal. Parents of children from St. Leonards or any other school, should collect their child from Penkridge Middle School at 2:30pm.**

On the evening, we would like to welcome all new parents to join us in person at Penkridge Middle School at **5pm** for a parent/carer transition evening (parents/carers only). This evening will be led by our Senior Leadership Team who will provide you with further key information needed for September.
